## **IMPORTANT** SUB: PROMOTION RULE B.SC. IN H&HA

Dear Principal,

The Board of Governors of the National Council in their 46th meeting approved revision in the promotion rule which will come into effect from the current academic year i.e. 2017-2018. The existing Examination Rules 2017 (w.e.f. July 2017) will be modified at Point No. 15 with regards to promotion for 3-year B.Sc. course as under:

EXISTING		PROPOSED
SEMESTER - I & II together (1st year)	Max. fail subjects - Six	Max. fail subjects - Six
SEMESTER - III & IV together (2 <sup>nd</sup> year)	Max. fail subjects – Three (of SEM-I, II, III & IV combined)	
SEMESTER - V & VI together (3 <sup>rd</sup> year)	Max. fail subjects - Six	Fail in One or more subjects - Compartment

It is thus illustrated that students can carry not more than six fail subjects of 1st year (SEM-I & SEMII) to 2<sup>nd</sup> year and similarly, 2<sup>nd</sup> year students (SEM-III & SEM-IV) can carry, besides six fail subjects of 1st year, three fail papers of 2nd year for promotion to 3rd year (SEM-V). In the third year, students securing fail in one or more subjects would be placed in compartment which they can clear subsequent to completion of 3rd year academic input i.e. as an external candidate but not beyond the maximum period of six years, as per Rule 4.7 of the Examination Rule.

These promotion rules will come into effect immediately from ongoing EVEN SEMESTER 2017-2018 examination.
